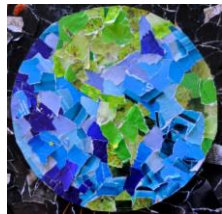

This week the children have been learning through the story of The Smeds and The Smoos. They have enjoyed carrying out lots of different activities including: counting aliens; counting out aliens into numbered rockets; drawing aliens; making aliens in the playdough; playing in the space small world tray; building rockets with the construction toys and creating shape rockets.
