This week the children have been busy learning through Nursery Rhyme Week. We have learnt: Incey Wincey Spider; Row, Row, Row Your Boat; Baa Baa Black Sheep and Down In The Jungle. The children have enjoyed lots of different activities based around these nursery rhymes including: painting; crafts; shape pictures; counting; drawing; playdough and retelling the rhymes using stick puppets. We will continue learning nursery rhymes and once learnt will send each one home for the children to add to their packs. The children are also doing really well learning the songs for the Nativity! 
We have also continued our learning through Ten Town this week. The children have been learning number 'two.' In Ten Town 'two' is known as Tommy Two; he helps King One in the castle and always does things in two's, which sometimes gets him in a bit of a pickle! We have explored what two looks like and have found different sets of two.

**Home Learning Challenge (optional): Explore the number two with your child. Can they carry out practical sets of two e.g. two claps, two jumps etc. Use their toys to make different sets e.g. 1 teddy, 2 dinosaurs, 3 cars, 2 trains. Can they find the sets of two? Can they match the numbers 1 and 2 to the right set? Can they spot numbers out and about e.g. house numbers? Can they find any sets of two around the house e.g. two socks, two shoes?
