



Dear Parents,

This week the children have been busy learning through the story of The Magic Porridge Pot. They have carried out lots of different activities including: going on a shape hunt; making their own magic porridge; painting a magic porridge pot; counting the magic ingredients in the pots; cutting images from the story and story sequencing. The children have also learnt the nursery rhyme Humpty Dumpty. They will be bringing the poem home on Monday which can be added to their nursery rhyme packs. Next week we will be learning through the story of The Nativity; the children are doing so well with their performance!

We have also continued our learning through Ten Town this week. The children have been learning number 'three.' In Ten Town 'three' is known as Thelma Three; she sometimes takes things that don't belong to her and is learning how to make the right choice! We have explored what three looks like and have found different sets of three.

Home Learning Challenge (optional): Explore the number three with your child. Can they carry out practical sets of three e.g. three claps, three jumps etc. Use their toys to make different sets e.g. 1 teddy, 2 dinosaurs, 3 cars, 3 trains. Can they find the sets of three? Can they match the numbers 1, 2 and 3 to the right set? Can they make sets of 1, 2 and 3 using their toys? Can they spot numbers out and about e.g. house numbers?
