Dear Parent

This is a simple letter to make clear the arrangements for your child's return to school in September. As you know your child will be taught by Miss Griffiths, supported by Mrs Madeley.

Your child should arrive at school at 8.50am and will be dismissed at 3.35pm.

Children will enter school via the Walton Gardens gate. Children can enter school through external class doors adjacent to the field by the yellow brick road and will be collected from here. At the start of the term, parents queue with their child up the yellow brick road against the wall to the right, leaving a 1 metre gap between you and the person in front. Parents are to ensure their child sanitizes their hands as they say their goodbyes and enter the building. Parents will not be permitted to enter the classroom, please prepare your child to be handed over to the member of staff on the door. If your child is upset, please move and stand with your child behind the staff, they will support you and your child once all children have entered. Parents then exit the school site via the Walton Gardens entrance keeping to the left. At the end of the day, parents queue in the same place and their child will be dismissed to them by staff.

Please don't worry if this sounds confusing! I will be on the playground on your child's first day ready to show you where to go. We will endeavour to also do some videos for you to help you and your child visualise their entry and exit points to school.

Your child will need:

- Named, weather appropriate clothing: sun hat, coats etc
- Named water bottle
- A [healthy lunchbox](#) if your child is not having a hot school dinner
