Dear Parent

This is a simple letter to make clear the arrangements for your child's return to school in September. As you know your child will be taught by Miss Bolton and Mrs Stevens and a team of support staff.

Your child should arrive at school as below:

Group	Arrival time	Collection time
Ladybirds	8.30am	11.30am
Dragonflies	8.40am	11.40am
Butterflies	8.50am	11.50am
Bumblebees	9.00am	12.00 noon

Children will line up at the gate on Belvide Gardens and will come through to the classroom as supported to by staff on the door. Parents will not be permitted to enter the classroom, please prepare your child to be handed over to the member of staff on the door. If your child is upset, please move and stand aside, staff will support you and your child once all other children have entered. Parents then exit the school site keeping to the left. At the end of the day, parents queue in the same place and their child will be dismissed to them by staff.

Parents will need to exit as quickly as they are able, to allow the next parent and child in. We appreciate that this is difficult with young children who are new to school.

Children will be dismissed to parents who should wait at 1m intervals on the pavement in Belvide Gardens. Staff will bring children out to you at the gate. Please note that in the early days this may take a little bit longer as children are settling in to the school routines. Children will come in at different times based on their group to limit congestion around the Nursery gate.

Your child will need:

- Named, weather appropriate clothing: sun hat, coats etc
- Named water bottle
- A [healthy lunchbox](#) if your child is not having a hot school dinner and is staying for lunch/all day
