**To take part in the Walking Bus scheme the following conditions must be adhered to:**

- In the morning I will take my child/children to the designated bus stop. **I will not leave my child/children until the "Driver" and "Conductor" of the bus, have both arrived;**
- I understand that it remains my responsibility to get my child to School safely, despite my consent to allow my child to use the walking bus;
- Children will be expected to wear their high visibility jacket, which will be provided;
- The parents escorting the children on the Walking Bus are covered by the County Council's Public Liability Insurance Policy;
- There is no personal accident insurance protection for any school children walking to or from school.
