



### Numeracy

We will be following the White Rose maths scheme this year and will focus this half term on addition and subtraction (within 20), place value, multiples of 2, 5 and 10 and measurement

### Literacy

We will be focusing on recounts, contemporary fiction, report writing and rhyming couplets.



### DT

Our DT work will focus on two different topics; vehicles and healthy eating.

This will include some art skills, as students will be designing different 'products' and evaluating their designs.

### Computing

In computing we are following the Purple Mash scheme of work that allows children to build on a range of skills both on and off the internet.

### History

Our history work focuses on castles and why they were built. We will be looking at different types of castles and how they have changed our landscape.

### P.E

Our outdoor PE will focus on multi skills, including balance, positioning and direction.

Indoor PE will be dance and focus on travelling in different ways and linking rhythmic patterns.

### Science

Our science focuses on materials and their uses. We will be identifying and naming materials and describing their properties.

### Music

Our music this term will be exploring tone and pitch of music and how altering this changes the dynamics of the music. We will also be studying medieval music to tie in with our topic work on castles.

### R.E

We will be looking at stories about Jesus and other religious leaders, primarily that of the Islamic faith.

### PSHE

We will be thinking about our community and how we can set and achieve our own goals.

### Phonics

The children will take part in a 30 minute daily phonics session learning new sounds and how we write them.
