



## Year 2 Curriculum Information - Summer Term

# Where do we live?

### Maths

In maths this term we will be covering

- Number and place value
- Addition and subtraction using an number line
- Multiplication and division fluency
- Fractions
- Problem solving/reasoning
- Shape

### Phonics

Children will continue to learn the spelling rules in Phase 6 along with the continued exposure to common exception words. Children should now be applying the rules they have learnt in their spellings with ease.

### RE

This half term our focus is how the gospels play a large part in Christianity as they spread good news. The final half of the term will be spent thinking about what 'faith' means to us.

### Music

Children will be using percussion instruments to perform in small groups. There will be a focus on tempo, pitch, beat and duration of music. Children will be asked to share their opinions on pieces of music.

### Science

Children will be investigating plants and their features. They will explore different seeds and be given the freedom to decide how they can sort them into different categories. Children will explore what happens to plants in different environments.

### Literacy

This term we will be looking at Quest stories and writing our own quest stories. We will focus on using different sentence types, using adjectives to add interest into our work as well as consolidating our writing skills in punctuation and grammar. We will be continuing to practise cursive handwriting and some children will start to join in their own work.

### Topic (Geography/History)

Children will be exploring the local area of Codsall from many years ago to the present day. We will be investigating how things have changed and why they have changed. Children will be analysing old and new maps of the local area and identifying similarities and differences of Codsall village as we know it today.

### PE

In PE our focus will be striking and fielding and later in the term, athletics.

### Art

We will look at the work of the artist William Morris and produce our own clay and paper tile inspired from nature. Children will make a mini model village of Codsall (look out for a message regarding boxes to be brought in). They will have to plan their shop front carefully and then complete a final design, ready to showcase St Nicholas' own mini Codsall!

### PSHE

This term children will be thinking about communities and feelings and relationships.

### Computing

We will be using the computers to make music, present our ideas and investigate how to code.
